SAFETY FIRST

Children are one of our church's most valuable assets! Part of our job as adults is to help children learn acceptable behavior in the classroom, the church, and the world. Rough play and running in church and on church grounds threatens everyone. In order to provide a safe environment for all, we are asking for parent/guardian help in the following ways:

- Children in **grades 5 and under** will not be released after class until a parent/guardian picks them up. I agree to pick up my child no later than 10 minutes after the service.

- I agree to discuss with my child or youth (and any guest who accompanies them) the importance of the safety of themselves and others; respect for other children and youth, adults and property; and the need to follow adult supervision in and out of the classroom. Any adult at CUUC has the authority to call children and youth on their behavior (as long as it does not violate the child's or youth's personal safety). Parents/guardians are expected to assist in any intervention if called upon.
